Booking an Appointment

We aim to offer a range of appointment types to suit individual needs and schedules. These include face-to-face consultations or consultations over the phone. We strive to ensure you communicate with the most appropriate member of our practice medical team – this includes doctors, nurse practitioners, practice pharmacists, nurses, and healthcare assistants.

If you need to book an appointment, please use our online Klinik form (link at top of our website homepage) or call us on 01691 648 054. You will initially be greeted with an automated bilingual message, choose the option for appointments and you will be transferred to one of our trained reception team. The receptionist will ask you some questions about why you are calling. They are doing this at the request of our GPs and this information is important to allow our receptionists to direct you to the most appropriate clinician to help you, which may not always be a GP. A member of the clinical team will contact you via phone, and if they feel that you need to be seen you will be given a day and time to visit the surgery.

Minor Injury Service

We offer a Minor Injuries open access service at Llanfyllin Medical Centre only. This service is available between the hours of 8:00am and 6:30pm. (Please note normal surgery hours are from 8:30am and only Minor Injuries will be dealt with from 8:00am).

Test Results

If your GP, nurse, or healthcare assistant carries out a test (such as a blood test, x-ray or smear), please make sure that you know how to find out the results. You may be asked to attend a surgery or call one of our team. Results will only be disclosed to the patient (or with consent to the parent or legal guardian). Remember even if your results are normal, yet you are still feeling unwell, we would wish to see you again.

Cancellations

It is important that you inform the reception staff if you are unable to attend your appointment as this will allow for that appointment to be offered to another patient. If you need to cancel your appointment, you can do so in the following ways:

Please ask for a call only if you are too ill or disabled to attend the surgery, where there are proper facilities. Lack of transport can often be overcome with the help of family, friends or neighbours.

The practice is an approved training practice to help qualified doctors in their final stages to become GPs. We also participate in the training of Medical Students. Consultations with GP Registrars will only take place with your prior approval and consent and may be recorded.

Prescriptions

To request prescriptions please allow 72 hours (3 full working days) notice. Any medication that is not on your repeat list may take up to 5 full working days to be fulfilled.

Ways to order your repeat medication:
